



Each week, as you step into your local elementary (and middle) school to meet with your student, you make a difference. For many mentors, they not only get to invest time and care into their students, they also come away rewarded and inspired.

Check out what some mentors shared about why they meet with their student each week:

- "I mentor because I believe God has placed a calling in my life to be seen as a role model for children. I pray that each hour I spend with my student, they can unwind and look forward to our time."
- "I mentor because I can see the positive impact our one hour together makes for my student! In the last two years my student has gone from scowling, angry, and not wanting to spend time together, to a smiling girl who is eager to tell me everything that has happened since we last met and doesn't want me to leave."
- "I mentor because I believe when kids know that they are seen, heard, and cared for, they can become their best selves."

The above article is from our recent Kids Hope Newsletter. I wanted to share it with you and to remind you that your time spent mentoring is important to your student, their teacher and to their parents/guardians. But it also goes further than that. When we mentor and pray for our students that are struggling in their daily life, we have become a comfort and a beacon of hope in their lives.

Thank you for giving of your time and sharing your faith. You have made a difference and continue to make a difference every time you meet with your student.

Severe Weather Cancellation Guidelines

If a Tornado Watch or Warning has been posted for Allegan County within one hour prior to a church service or church activity, the service/activity will be cancelled. Also, if a Severe Thunderstorm Warning has been posted for Allegan County within one hour of any church service or church activity, the service/activity will be cancelled. Leaders and chairs of committees have the right to conduct an event during a cancellation if they deem the conditions are safe. In such cases, the leaders and chairs are responsible for notifying members and participants to inform them the event is still taking place and where they will be meeting.
