

families, members of the congregation (and



You are asked to bring 3 of your favorite things:


- all 3 items can be identical

- ⊕ each item must be valued at approx. \$10 (totaling approx. \$30 for the 3)


During the evening, you will be choosing 3 different items to take home-3 other ladies favorites.
