

The Deacons have brought to the Consistory's attention that our cash flow has narrowed and needs bolstering in order to avoid discomfort financially. The feeling of Consistory was that the Congregation cannot address what it does not know. Any additional giving is most appreciated in addressing this item.

Those desiring additional information are invited to speak with Deacon Chair, Todd Burton or Treasurer, Tyler Taratuta. Some will wonder what has changed or how did we get here? The simple answer is that we believe recent weather patterns have decreased giving in the short-term. This fact, combined with extensive addressing of deferred maintenance over the past two years has tightened our finances. Giving for 2024 exceeded budget and made the targeted 2025 budget not only reachable, but also reflective of what was received in 2024. All indications are that the best present course of action is simply informing the Congregation.

We have shared what we know, but our greatest offering of what we know is simply this: that throughout the history of our church and through the many generations of the faithful who have come before, we hold onto God's faithfulness in always providing what we need.

Consistory Chronicles

March Elders / Consistory Meetings

The Consistory met in March and reviewed reports, considered policy updates and discussed next steps.

The Elders shared that they continue to review and evaluate the Pastoral Care of the congregation following the departure of Pastor Ron Lugten. This includes updates from Pastor Kevin, and the relaunching of the *Friends at Home* ministry.

The Deacons continue to review our financial position and budget, and would like to thank the congregation for its initial response to the *Financial Update* found in the *Heartbeat* publication these past few weeks. Among our challenges, we are striving to raise our reserves for better cash flow.

Our *Articles of Incorporation Transition Team* provided a quick update on how our transition progresses. We anticipate final steps to be completed in June.

The Consistory has approved a Paid Sick Leave policy to begin in October to come into alignment with the law of the State of Michigan.

The Consistory is reviewing various policy updates including van usage, our Child Safety Policy, and consideration of a Knox Box (used by the Fire Department for access to our church). Additionally, a building use request is under consideration and review.

The next Executive Team meeting is scheduled for Monday, April 21. The next Elders and Consistory meetings are scheduled for Monday, April 28.

If a Tornado Watch or Warning has been posted for Allegan County within one hour prior to a church service or church activity, the service/activity will be cancelled. Also, if a Severe Thunderstorm Warning has been posted for Allegan County within one hour of any church service or church activity, the service/activity will be cancelled. Leaders and chairs of committees have the right to conduct an event during a cancellation if they deem the conditions are safe. In such cases, the leaders and chairs are responsible for notifying members and participants to inform them the event is still taking place and where they will be meeting.
