

Consistory Chronicles

September Elders / Consistory Meetings

The Consistory met in late September, receiving reports, furthering on-going work, and addressing presenting items.

- The Elders shared membership items were discussed and that World Communion will happen on October 5.
- The Deacons gave an update on activities, including the volunteer upkeep of the grounds over this summer. Initial work towards the 2026 Budget has begun. A financial update was also given.
- Discussion concerning Congregational Life included promotion of the 55+ Group Breakfast upcoming and review of Meal preparation and clean-up for our Wednesday Night Programming.
- Service and Outreach shared the success of our Local Mission Trip to Camp Beechpoint where over 170 feet of shelving was finished and a wrap-around deck was both power-washed and fully stained.
- The Consistory continued discussion and feedback as it works with the Security Team to fine-tune the safety and security of the congregation. This remains an on-going work.
- We received an update for our Task Force on remaining items to be addressed within our transfer from the RCA to the Alliance of Reformed Churches.
- Finally, the Consistory received the Nominations for Elders and Deacons for 2026 and took the appropriate steps to further the process.
- The next Executive Team meeting is scheduled for Monday, October 20. The next Elders and Consistory meetings are scheduled for Monday, October 27.
