

Maundy Thursday Stations of the Cross



Join us on Thursday, April 17, for a Maundy Thursday journey through five stations of the cross. Arrive at church anytime between 6:00pm and 6:45pm. You will wait in the lobby and then enter station #1 (Fellowship Hall) after the group ahead of you exits. You will stay in a

group of 16-20 people and proceed together through each station. Consistory members, Pastor Kevin and other volunteers will facilitate the stations, which include communion, scripture, singing, videos and nailing a nail into a cross. This experience will help you reflect on what Jesus went through during the final 24 hours before he died. A nursery will be provided. One station will be outdoors (weather permitting), so you may want a coat. You are encouraged to leave in silent reflection following the final station.
