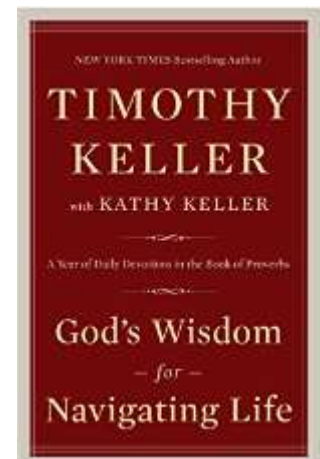
Read a chapter of Proverbs a day:

The Future of the RCA and Sunday Seminar

Over the past several years the RCA has been wrestling with its identity as a denomination and the stance it will take on the issue of same-sex marriage. In 2020, a major event will be taking place at the highest level of the RCA to determine our next steps. Currently on the table are options:

1. To do nothing about this issue and allow tensions to remain high; leading to an uncertain and unstable future.
2. To restructure the RCA so that churches and classis' may determine their own convictions; allowing congregations to remain under the broad heading of the denomination.
3. To undergo the process of a grace-filled separation where congregations may leave the RCA based upon the decisions of the Synod this coming summer.

Since any one of these options, or variations of them, will most likely impact our church I have invited the president of Zeeland Classis to lead a Sunday Seminar on January 5 at 10:45 in the Sanctuary. I believe his presentation will help our congregation understand what is going on in the RCA and what is at stake. Please clear your schedule and attend this short seminar if at all possible. 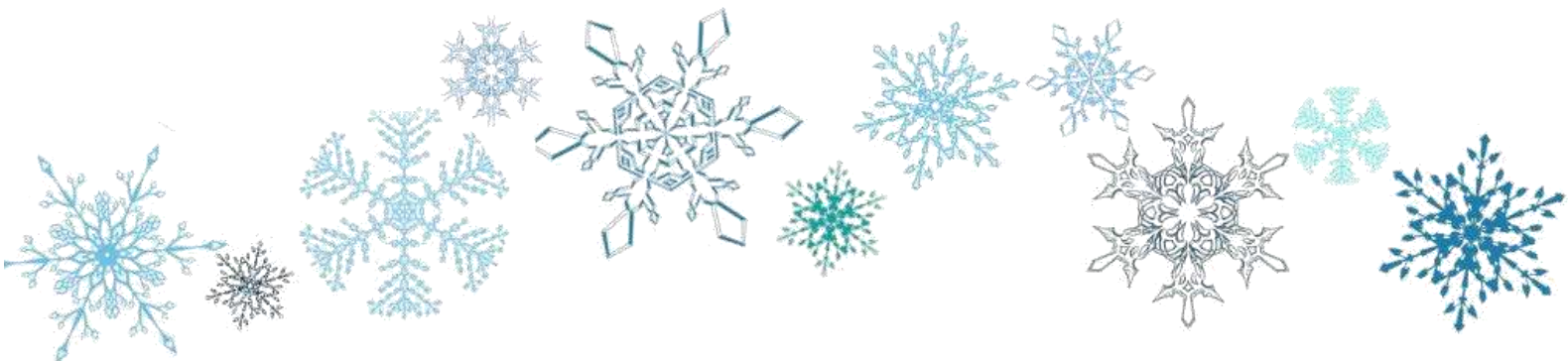
When winter session of Kid Connection begins, we will continue collecting mittens, gloves, hats, and socks.

2019 Chili Cook-Off Results



1st Place – Grace Lindholm “Slap Yo Momma”

- 1 lb. ground beef
- 1 small white onion, diced
- 3 – 15 oz. cans diced tomatoes with green chilies
- 1 – 15 oz. can red kidney beans, drained
- 1 – 15 oz. can of Bush’s mild or medium chili beans
- 2 TBSP chili powder

1. In a large pot cook the ground beef over medium-high until browned – stirring frequently.
2. Using a slotted spoon transfer beef to a separate plate and set aside.
3. Reserve one tablespoon of grease in pot and discard rest.
4. Add onion to the pot and sauté in the grease for 4-5 minutes until soft.
5. Add remaining ingredients and the beef back into the pot and stir.
6. Bring to a boil, then reduce heat to mid-low, cover and simmer for 10 minutes.

2nd Place – Jessi Boerman “What ‘chu Talkin’ ’bout Chilis”

- 1 lb. boneless/skinless chicken breasts
- 1 yellow onion, diced
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 24 oz. chicken broth
- 2 – 15 oz. cans northern beans, drained and rinsed
- 2 – 4 oz. cans diced green chiles
- 15 oz. can corn, drained
- ½ tsp. chili powder
- ½ tsp. black pepper
- 1 tsp. cumin
- ¾ tsp. oregano
- ¼ tsp. cayenne pepper
- small handful fresh cilantro, chopped
- 4 oz. cream cheese, softened
- ¼ cup half & half

1. Place chicken breasts in bottom of slow cooker, top with salt, pepper, cumin, oregano, chili powder and cayenne pepper.
2. Top with onion, garlic, beans, chiles, corn, chicken broth and cilantro. Stir everything together.
3. Cover and cook on low for 8 hours or on high for 3-4 hours.
4. Remove chicken and shred. Return to slow cooker.
5. Add cream cheese and half & half, stir, then cover and cook on high for 15 minutes or until chili is creamy and thickened.
